Camp Fires: Burn permits are required in order to have any type of fire. Please obtain a permit and call the number at the top of the permit each time you start and end your burn. **Do not bring firewood from outside sources**.

Dog By-law: Dogs are required to have a tag, including those visiting the Township for more than 7 days, and no more than 3 dogs are allowed to be registered at a property. Dogs must be leashed when off the property. Ensure that you are picking up your dogs' feces (off of public and private property) and disposing of it in the correct manner (By-law 2021-11, Responsible Dog Ownership).

Watercraft/Recreational Vehicles: Please ensure that all watercraft and recreational vehicles are washed off when going into and out of waterways or Township property to ensure that there is no transfer of unnatural species.

Parking: Only park on the homeowner's property, do not block driveways, roadways or right of ways.

Noise By-law: Please ensure that you are being respectful of the noise level that is created from your property, especially during the night (By-law 2003-59, Prohibit and Regulate Noises within the Township).

All the information a renter may ask for!

Septic Information: Please do not flush feminine hygiene products, paper towel, oils, grease and fat, disposable diapers, facial tissues, plastics and cigarette filters.

Pedestrian Safety: Be mindful of high traffic areas. Always practice safe walking when walking on the roadside of busy roads. Wear bright clothing that will allow you to be seen easily, even reflective materials! (OVER)
