To be a leader in the region by developing and supporting the growth and expansion of local business and employment opportunities

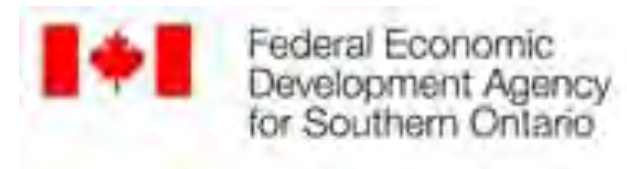


About Community Futures
