

Synopsis of Report: To discuss potential student funded opportunities for summer 2019.

Overview: In order to undertake summer programming, we will need to hire a summer student. We did not budget for Canada Summer Jobs this year, which requires we pay 50% of the student's salary. As we received Summer Experience Funding in 2018 we are (according to Ministry officials) very unlikely to receive it in 2019. Another avenue to pursue is Youth Job Connect through Employment Peterborough, which will reimburse us 100% for 15 hours/week.

Recommendation: That the library utilize the Youth Job Connect Summer Program to select a summer student to run the TD Summer Reading Program in 2019, and that we actively recruit youth volunteers to assist with running summer programming.

Financial Impact: All staffing costs will be reimbursed through this program.

Impact to Library Staff: Staff will be able to oversee summer programming.

Impact to Library Services: The library will be able to provide summer programming to the community.
