Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (c.32) as amended

Notice is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the Township of Douro-Dummer that nomination papers are available in the Clerk's Office, in the Township of Douro-Dummer, for the following offices:

- Mayor (1)** - Elected by General Vote
- Deputy Mayor (1)** - Elected by General Vote
- Councillor at Large (1)** - Elected by General Vote
- Councillor Douro Ward (1)** - Elected by Douro Ward Electors
- Councillor Dummer Ward (1)** - Elected by Dummer Ward Electors

Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board- (1) Trustee

- representing the Townships of Cavan Monaghan, Douro-Dummer and Otonabee-South Monaghan) nominations accepted by Cavan Monaghan.

Peterborough-Victoria-Northumberland and Clarington Catholic District School Board (1) Trustee

- representing the Townships of Asphodel-Norwood, Cavan Monaghan, Douro-Dummer, Trent Lakes, Havelock-Belmont-Methuen, Otonabee-South Monaghan, North Kawartha and Selwyn- nominations accepted by Selwyn.

Conseil Scolaire Viamonde (Secteur 1) (French Language Public School Board) - (1) Trustee

- representing the Counties of Northumberland, Peterborough, and Haliburton, the City of Kawartha Lakes, the City of Peterborough, the City of Quinte West and Durham Region.

Conseil Scolaire catholique MonAvenir (Region 11) (1) Trustee

- representing the Durham Region, Peterborough County, Northumberland County, Hastings County, City of Kawartha Lakes, City of Peterborough and City of Quinte West.

Nominations may be made by completing and filing in the office of the Clerk, nominations on the prescribed form and accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the Head of Council and \$100 for all other offices. The filing fee is payable by cash, debit, certified cheque or money order.

A nomination must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent during regular business hours between May 1, 2018 and July 26, 2018, and between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. on July 27, 2018 (Nomination Day). A nomination for council must also include endorsement signatures from at least twenty-five (25) persons who are eligible to vote in an election within the municipality where a nomination is being submitted.

Registration papers for third party advertisers must be signed by a representative and may be filed in the Office of the Clerk in person or by an agent during regular business hours from May 1, 2018, up to and including October 19, 2018. Registration papers along with a Declaration of Qualification must be certified by the Clerk before such entity becomes a Certified Third Party Advertiser.

In the event there are an insufficient number of certified candidates to fill all positions available, nominations will be reopened for the vacant positions **only** on Wednesday, August 1, 2018, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. and such additional nominations, if required, may be filed in the office of the Clerk.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, **voting by internet or telephone** will be opened at 10:00 a.m. on October 9th to 8:00 p.m. on October 22nd, 2018.

Voting Day is Monday, October 22, 2018.
