2018 Final Residential Taxes

2018 Final Taxes are **due on June 30th and September 30th**. Penalty for late payment is at the rate of 1.25% per month, effective the 1st day of the month of default and each month thereafter.

Sign up for our pre-authorized payment plan. The application form is available at www.dourodummer.on.ca
No need to worry about missing due dates or incurring penalty!

Tax Payment Options Available:

- Pre-authorized Payment Plan – either due date or monthly**
- Visa/MasterCard Payment - township website, telephone or at the Municipal Office – taxpayer responsible for service fee at a rate of 1.75%.
- Telebanking or internet banking – pay 2-3 days prior to due date to allow for transmission and processing
- In person at most banks - you must have your tax bill with you when making payments.
- Canada Post – taxpayer assumes responsibility for late arrival.
- Drop box located at the main doors of the municipal building in Warsaw for after-hours payments.
- In person at the Municipal Office, using cash, cheque, interact, or credit card.

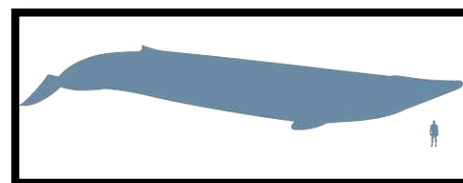


Parking and stopping is prohibited on Strickland Street from the boundary of the Township of Selwyn and the Township of Douro-Dummer to Highway 28 (in front of Morton Medical Centre) By-Law 2014-57.

Parking is also prohibited on portions of Crowe's Landing Road and McCracken's Landing Road. A private security company has been engaged by the township to monitor these locations so please respect the NO PARKING areas- your vehicle may be at risk of being towed.

Open Air Burning By-Law 2015-05

Recreation campfires to a maximum of 1m²

Conventional fires, a maximum of 3m x 3m x 2m in height requires a permit – no fee.

Special Occurrence Permit applies to any fire that does not meet either of the above type fires - \$25 fee. An inspection is mandatory. Visit www.dourodummer.on.ca to read the By-Law for clearances and set fees for violations.

Carbon Monoxide Alarms

It is now law that all residential buildings have carbon monoxide alarms near all sleeping areas. (Exemption to this rule is, only electric heating and no attached garage) Multi-residential units require one in service rooms as well.

Carbon monoxide alarms can be hardwired, battery-operated or plugged into the wall. Already have a smoke alarm outside the sleeping area that needs replacing? Now available, are smoke/CO alarm combination units.

Emergency Management Program

In the event of an emergency, simply call **9-1-1**. If using a cell phone or a VOIP phone, your location may not be automatically determined. Please ensure you know the civic address and Township you are located in. An integral part of this system is the property identification numbers (green signs with white numbers) at the end of your driveway or at your dock. Without these numbers, emergency vehicles will not be able to easily find your location, thus delaying response to your emergency. Intense storms are becoming the new normal. Ensure you have a plan and a 72 hour kit prepared to help you and your family while damaged infrastructure is being restored.
