SPRING MAINTENANCE FOR TRENT-SEVERN WATERWAY BRIDGES

Peterborough, Ontario, April 6, 2018 – In the coming weeks, Parks Canada will be conducting spring maintenance at some of our swing bridges and sites along the Trent-Severn Waterway, in preparation for the 2018 navigation season. This includes preventative maintenance tasks like washing and greasing swing bridges and conducting visual inspections to ensure their safe operability.

Temporary Bridge Closures

Parks Canada advises residents and visitors of the following temporary bridge closures for regular spring maintenance, weather permitting:

- McFarlane Street Bridge (Peterborough), 24 hours
April 10, 2018 at 6:00 am until April 11, 2018 at 6:00 am – inclusive
- Warsaw Road Swing Bridge (Peterborough)
May 1, 2018 from 9:00 am to 2:30 pm
- Maria Street Swing Bridge (Peterborough), 48 hours
April 20, 2018 at 6:00 am until April 22, 2018 at 6:00 am - inclusive

Traffic Delays

Seasonal maintenance on certain bridges that cross the Trent-Severn Waterway will not result in closures, but vehicles may experience short delays of about 10 minutes:

April 9 to mid-May

Bobcaygeon Swing Bridge

Hamlet Swing Bridge (on Canning Road near Washago)
Port Severn Swing Bridge
